

Access for guests: UCSD-GUEST

The UCSD-GUEST wireless network is for visitors and guests, and is an unencrypted service requiring daily user registration. As a guest using this service, you can:

- Browse the Web, including webmail (e.g., gmail)
- Use [VPN](#) to access your home institution
- Use SSH
- Use most secure e-mail clients

To connect as a guest:

1. Select the UCSD-GUEST wireless network.
2. Open your browser and bring up a Web site.
3. Follow the instructions to enter your e-mail address and accept the Terms of Use.
4. Click Guest Login.
5. You will be connected to the requested Web site within 2 minutes.

You will be asked to re-enter your e-mail address daily to continue using the network.
