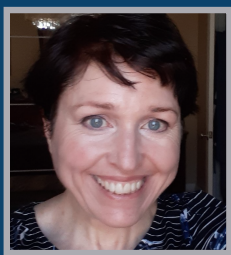

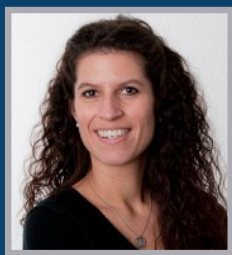
- How would self-regulation, cognitive control, executive functions, and their associations be defined?

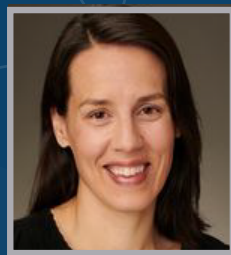
